Dunoon Spectator Information

Friday 23rd June

There are multiple spectator points within the town that will allow you to enjoy the spectacle of the 2023 Dunoon Presents Argyll Rally. All spectator areas will be clearly identified with black and yellow tape and green "Spectator" arrows.

Once the road is closed spectators must not walk on the stage route. Doing so could jeopardise the running of the stage. The roads used for the stage within Dunoon will close at 18:00. After this time you must not walk or drive on the stage route.

Spectators will only be permitted to walk or drive on the stage route once the road has official re-opened. The opening of the road will be signified by the passing of the "Road Open" vehicle. This car will be identified with large signs on the side and red flashing lights. The roads will re-open no later than 23:04

There is one designated crossing point located at the bottom of Argyll Street at the Queens' Hall. This crossing point will be open throughout the running of the stage but you must follow the instructions of the marshals when crossing.

At all times please remember:

- Respect the marshals and follow their instructions
- Observe the colour coded tape and stand back from any tape, walls and fences
- Read and understand any safety signage. If you are not sure please speak to a marshal who will be happy to help.
- Don't walk or drive on the rally stage when the roads are closed
- Remain alert, rally cars can do what you least expect
- Do not walk beyond the marked spectator area
- Take all litter and belongings home with you

Spectator Information

There are multiple spectator points as detailed below to allow you to enjoy this years Dunoon Presents Argyll Rally. There is no set charge for parking at these spectator locations, however, at each location there will be people collecting money for charity. The suggested donation is £10 per car. All money collected will be donated to charity.

All spectator areas will be clearly arrowed with green "Spectator" arrows. The directions below utilise What3Words and we recommend downloading this app to aide finding each location.

Once the road is closed spectators must not walk on the stage route. Doing so could jeopardise the running of the stage. Each road is closed at the times detailed below and will be signified by the passing of the "Road Closed" vehicle. This car will be identified with large signs on the side of the vehicle and red flashing lights.

Spectators will only be permitted to walk or drive on the stage route once the road has official re-opened. The opening of the road will be signified by the passing of the "Road Open" vehicle. This car will be identified with large signs on the side and red flashing lights.

At all times please remember:

- Respect the marshals and follow their instructions
- Observe the colour coded tape and stand back from any tape, walls and fences
- Read and understand any safety signage. If you are not sure please speak to a marshal who will be happy to help.
- Don't walk or drive on the rally stage when the roads are closed between the "Road Closing" and "Road Opening" vehicles with red lights
- Remain alert, rally cars can do what you least expect
- Do not walk beyond the marked spectator area
- Take all litter and belongings home with you
- Do not light fires




